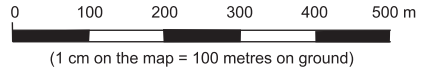

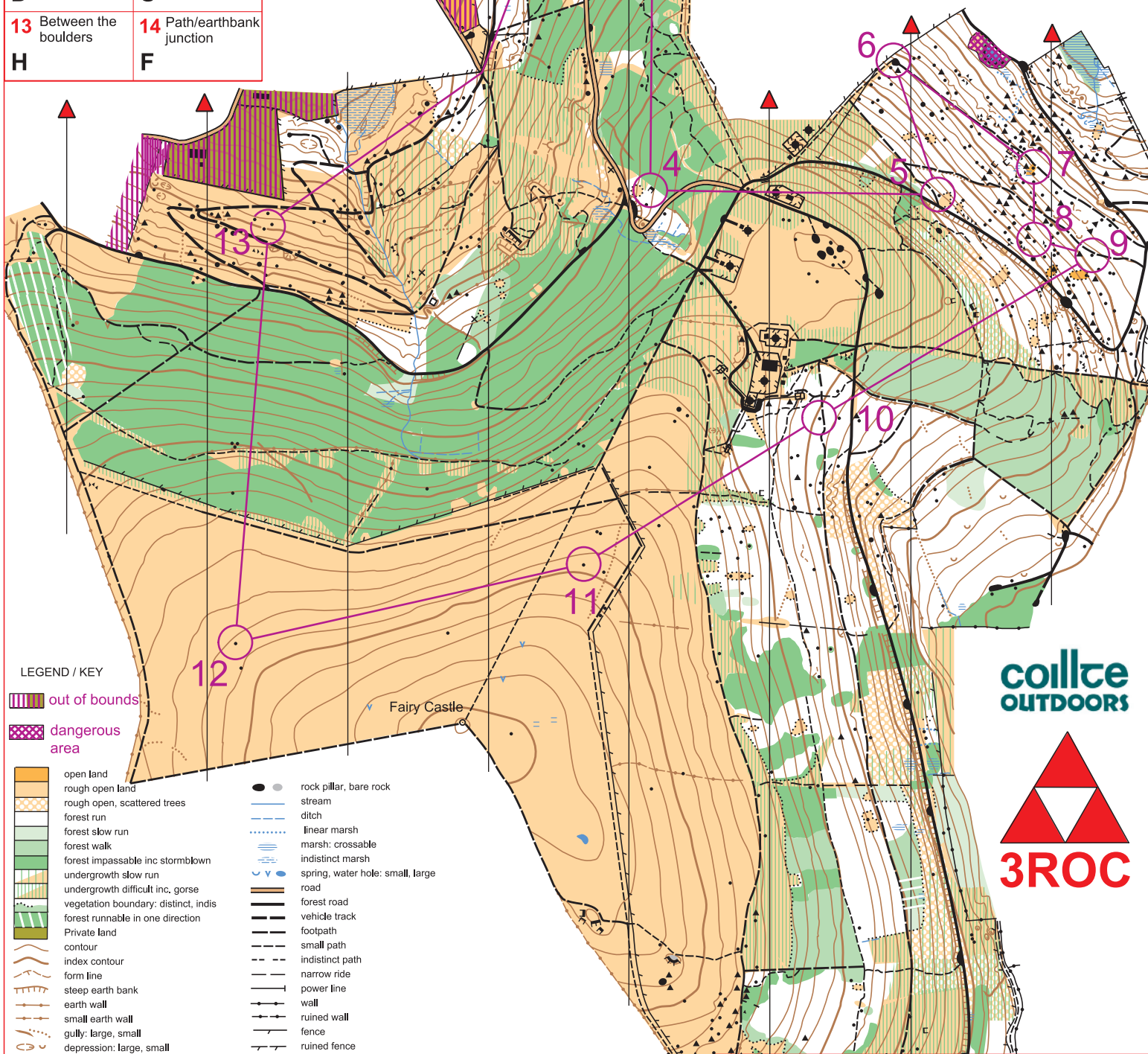


1. Visit the controls in the order shown on the map
