**Finn van Gelderen – Communications**: Finn gave a summary of his activities which include Leaflets for Schools O, Facebook Likes and unused WOC video footage.

**Harold White – Technical:** Major event conference to be held on January 17<sup>th</sup> 2015. Course standards will be one of the items on the agenda. There is also work underway on Colour Course Standards, these are expected to be finished Oct 2014.

**Chris Slattery – Mapping:** Three main activities at the moment.

Computers in Orienteering Workshop: Scheduled for Nov 22<sup>nd</sup>. The topics and speakers are being planned.

LIDAR Grant: The grant for €39,000 was approved by the Dept of Transport,

Tourism and Sport. The IOA must pay 15% towards LIDAR purchases. Clubs will be
approached requesting areas they wish LIDAR data on, emphasis on areas that will
be used for Championship events in the next few years. Clubs will be expected to
make a small contribution towards the cost of the LIDAR.

Map Registrations: Ready to send out list of maps registered to second group of clubs. They may be a need to fast track parts of the process for the Shamrock ORingen maps. A teleconference meeting was arranged to discuss this.
