
Procedure for Dealing with a Suspected Case

1. The affected person(s) should be immediately isolated and accompanied by the Club's Covid-19 Liaison person (or designated alternate) to the Designated Isolation Area. For orienteering purposes, the Designated Isolation Area will be the affected person's car. The Covid-19 Liaison will keep at least 2 metres distance from the affected party and will ensure all others do too.
2. The affected person and any travelling companions must be directed to return home immediately from where they must call their doctor and commence self-isolation. The affected person(s) must avoid touching people, surfaces, and objects and cover their mouth with a disposable tissue if they cough or sneeze.
3. The affected person must also be directed to inform the organising club of the results of the Covid-19 test.
4. The Covid-19 Liaison Person must complete a written report of the incident and notify the IOA.
5. The organising club should immediately clean all potentially contaminated areas.
6. If the suspected case subsequently turns out to be positive, the club must provide the HSE Contact Tracing Team with the contact details of all participants and helpers on the day. This list must be held in electronic form and contain, at a minimum, the name and phone number of each person. The club should also inform all participants themselves.
